

2017 Classic Red Blend Paso Robles

Tasting Notes:

Comprised of a blend of several varietals grown in the Central Coast, this fruit-forward, voluptuous wine has a rich and plush texture, with a dark garnet color. There are violet and herbal notes on the nose, accented by spice and savoriness.

About the Winemakers:

The ultra-premium wines of Lightpost Winery are the result of the hard work and dedication of winemakers Sofia Fedotova and Christian Roguenant. Sofia, a successful entrepreneur, has long been fascinated with wine and started the winery after receiving a winemaker certificate from UC Davis. Christian has won numerous awards for his wines. His Champagne was served in the 1984 Olympic games. He was a judge for over 100 International wine competitions. In 2017, Christian was voted by industry peers as the California Central Coast winemaker of the year.

Blend: 50 % Grenache Paso Robles Niners vineyard, 15 % Syrah San Luis Obispo Edna Valley, 10 % Carignan Paso Robles Contra Costa vineyard, 10% Mourvedre Paso Robles Contra Costa vineyard, 10% Malbec Paso Robles Red Hills vineyard, 5% Syrah Edna Valley

Oak regimen: 50 % new French oak for 29 months.

Alcohol: 14.9%
